

On July 15 at a meeting of the RC 10 Executive Committee the following amendment to the RC 10 Constitution was approved to be recommended to the Board of Directors for their recommendation to the General Membership. On that same day, the Board of Directors voted to accept the recommendation of the Executive Committee and to circulate the amendment to the membership with a vote to be held at the Fall business luncheon on September 9 at the Cambridge Hotel.

The purpose of this amendment is to bring in-line our Constitutional language with requirement of the American Federation of Teachers under Subsection 5a. It is also the intent to further clarify the duties of the RC 10 Treasurer. The change in Section f is to include the NEA when electing delegates.

Article VI

- e. Duties of the Treasurer
 1. The Treasurer shall hold all funds of the Council and pay all pending bills.
 2. The Treasurer shall reimburse all vouchers upon authorization by the Executive Committee.
 3. All checks representing disbursements from the treasury shall be signed by the Treasurer and at least one other officer designated by the Board of Directors.
 4. The Treasurer shall (bill members):
 - a. receive from the Membership Committee all annual Sustaining Member Activity fees and,
 - b. maintain accurate records of receipts and disbursements and,
 - c. prepare an annual financial report, and,
 - d. aid in the preparation of the annual budget, and
 - e. help to maintain an accurate membership list with the Membership Committee].
 5. Shall in compliance with sections 1-4 of this section [and in accordance with all national affiliate guidelines], work closely with the [RC 10 Auditing Committee, Article IX, Section 10 of this

Constitution, to complete the annual financial review and to submit such review to the national affiliates Financial Services Department].

[a. A committee of 3 to 5 members (excluding the Treasurer) shall be appointed by the Board of Directors to complete the financial review according to the guidelines and procedures established by the national affiliates.

b. This review shall constitute also as the annual Local financial review as stipulated in Article 9, Section 10 Auditing Committee].

f. Nominations and Election Committee

1. The nominating committee shall propose a slate of officers and NYSUT/AFT/[NEA] Delegates and Alternates for election by the General membership at the annual spring meeting.
