NYSUT has one of the most successful union retiree programs in the country. What started over 30 years ago with approximately 33,000 retiree members, has now grown to nearly 270,000 and counting! Today's NYSUT retirees were the activists who gave birth to our union 51 years ago and continue to actively participate in all NYSUT's programs and initiatives. They work phone banks to elect endorsed



candidates; they attend marches and rallies; they work for civil rights, social justice and women's rights; they work to support their in-service colleagues; they fight to protect Medicare and Social Security; they provide scholarships and teacher grants; they donate books and school supplies for children in local districts; they support local food banks; they deliver meals to the elderly and infirmed; they plan interesting, informative and educational programs to keep seniors engaged and informed...and the list goes on.

In recognition of their work and commitment to our Union, the third Monday in October each year shall be designated NYSUT RETIREE RECOGNITION DAY

The first annual Retiree Recognition Day celebration was held in Western New York at the NYSUT office on Monday, October 21, 2024.
