
## 21ST ANNUAL EDUCATIONAL LEGISLATIVE FORUM

The 21st Annual Educational Legislative Forum sponsored by the Catskill Regional Teacher Center will be held on February 8th at SUNY Oneonta Morris Hall's Craven Lounge from 4:30 pm to 6:00 pm. The Forum serves as an opportunity for teachers and legislators from five counties to engage in educational discourse. Attendees will gain valuable insights into the dynamic relationship between the State Education Department, The Board of Regents, and the New York State Legislature. The Catskill Regional Teacher Center provides professional development and access to resources to approximately 2,500 educators in the DCMO and ONC BOCES Regions, covering thirty-five districts in Chenango, Delaware, Greene, Otsego, Madison, and Schoharie Counties, including private and public schools.


#### **HIDDEN GEMS: BOWMAN LAKE STATE PARK**

With the rural makeup of most of Chenango County, **Bowman Lake State Park** provides opportunities of quiet and relaxation during all 4 seasons. Biking, boating, fishing, hiking, hunting, and winter snowmobiling and cross-country skiing are favorite activities here. It is a 967-acre remote retreat **known as "a camper's paradise"**. Scenic park roads wind through evergreen and hardwood forests to 150 campsites and 8 cabins. There is a sandy lakefront for swimmers and sunbathers with several picnic areas nearby. The lake is regularly stocked with trout, and birdwatchers can spot as many as 103 species of birds. There are over 13 miles of scenic trails for hiking as well as marked snowmobile and cross-country trails for winter enjoyment.



Bowman Lake State Park also participates in the Summer and Winter Parks Geocaching Challenge providing new summer and winter caches each year. President Vicki Darrow and her husband visit this park several times a year!
