## **ADVOCACY IN ACTION: NYSUT COMMITTEE OF 100 - 2024**

The Committee of 100 met in Albany to discuss education issues with the legislators on March 5. There were over 500 NYSUT educators meeting for 30 minutes in small groups with legislators.

Some of the issues we discussed included fully funding Foundation Aid, fighting childhood poverty, expanding the community school model, supporting the New Deal for Higher Education, fixing tiers 5 and 6, changing BOCES funding formula which was based on the salary of a teacher in 1990, restoring funding for Teacher Centers, returning APPR to local control, protecting students and staff from extreme heat in school, replacing



the receivership system, and ensuring staff and services at special schools. In Senator Oberacker's district 41 schools showed a severe reduction in Foundation Aid.

I met with Senator Oberacker, Senator May, Senator Webb, and Assemblyperson Kelles or their representative. All of them agreed with our issues but there will be negotiations with the governor, senate, and assembly before a final budget will be approved. NYSUT also supplied us with information about revenue proposed bills like the Capital Gains Bill, the Progressive Income Tax Bill, Corporate Tax Reforms Bill, and the Billionaires Tax Bill. Please continue sending money to <u>Vote-Cope</u> (voluntary non-partisan political action group) to help improve education issues and to fund the activities of the Committee of 100. *~Diana Torta NYSUT RC #45 Committee of 100 Delegate*
